

## HOUSE RULES OF COURTESY

- **Protect all players and the hack:** Following contact of two or more stones (take outs, hits, etc.), players in the house should make every effort to keep control of moving stones to ensure they remain in and on that games ice sheet.
- **Players will keep their hands and knees off the ice.**
- **All players shall maintain their equipment (no street shoes). Brooms and sliders must be in good condition.**
- **Teams are expected to play at a reasonable pace. Players should be in the hack waiting for instructions from the skip.**
- **8 ends = 2 hours.**
- **Leads and Seconds should stand between the hog lines and to the side when not throwing or sweeping.**
- **All players should avoid crossing the ice in front of or behind anyone who is in the hack getting ready to throw.**
- **Tables 1-6 on the first floor are for players who have just completed their game. Please vacate when players start to come off the ice.**
- **At CFB Halifax Curling Club winners buy the first round.**
